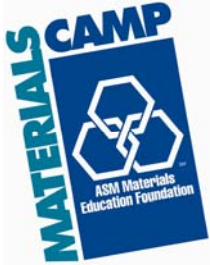


# Attend a one-week training in Summer 2007 – FREE!
